Carers Rights in a time of pandemic

“Carer-friendly employers are better prepared to meet changing staff needs through the Covid-19 pandemic” Carers UK Employer Survey November 2020

Employees who are confident about their families’ well-being are better able to contribute more to the work environment. The pandemic has created many more new family carers, people – most in their 40s and 50s and in employment – who have started caring unpaid for previously independent family members and friends who are now vulnerable to COVID-19. A recent survey of employers by [CarersUK](#) found that an additional 2.8 million workers took on caring responsibilities since the outbreak of COVID-19 and were experiencing the stresses and strains of juggling caring and work life. 90% of Employers surveyed had put in place additional support and flexible working arrangements for staff, helping them to retain skilled workers rather than recruiting and retraining new.

As well as helping carers know their rights, the annual [Carers Rights Day](#) provides an opportunity for employers to reflect on their offer for the 1 in 8 workers who are working carers.

For SMEs responding to this agenda is challenging. This where is Caring4Elders’ bespoke service can be a lifeline.
